

Seven Biblical Principles to Victory

1. I am convinced that without Christ I am unable to manage my life and control the desires within me. Romans 7:15-25; Romans 3:23; Galatians 5:17-24
2. I believe that there is a God who created me, that He loves and understands me, and that He alone can make me a new person. Hebrews 11:6; 2 Corinthians 5:17.
3. I believe that Jesus Christ is God's son, and that through his death and victory over sin, I can be set free from the bondage of sin and the heavy load of guilt that I carry. Romans 1:3-4; Romans 5:8-10; John 8:36; Ephesians 2:1-9.
4. At this point I turn my life, my will, and my problems over to God and receive Jesus as the lord of my life. I take Jesus as my savior and claim all that is mine in him. John 1:12; Romans 12:1-2; Colossians 2:6-Z
5. I will allow God, through the Holy Spirit, to guide me to continually take inventory of my life, and I will promptly admit my wrongdoing and ask God to forgive me and give me victory over them. 1 John 1:9; Romans 6:16; Romans 8:11-14.
6. Having been set free, I realize I must never again trifle with the sin that held me in bondage. 2 Peter 2:20-22; Matthew 12:43-45; Hebrews 3:12-13.
7. I realize I must seek God's will for my life through continuous prayer, and daily study of God's word. I must also seek new friendships, and be totally committed to Christ's church and its mission. 1 Thessalonians 5:17; 2 Timothy 2:15; 1 Peter 4:1-5; Hebrews 10:19-24

The ‘Problem’ and the ‘Solution’

Drunkenness, drug addiction, Pornography addiction, compulsive gambling, and abusive behavior are just some examples of addictive behaviors that are driven by man’s spiritual emptiness, inner fear and raging anger. These life controlling sins can only be broken by a deep relationship with God through His son Jesus Christ.

Romans 8:35-37 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written, for thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

These are things that we as people experience in life; some more than others. There is always some trial, some distress, some rejection or persecution coming our way. These are our giants.

Prior to becoming a follower of Christ, we developed sinful attitudes and sinful ways of dealing with the trials, rejections and temptations of life. These attitudes and reactions are used by Satan to build addictive behavior, strongholds, and life controlling bondages in our lives. However, as believers in Christ we are promised that we can not only overcome these strongholds, we can be more than a conqueror.

God’s Word does not say that the trials, and rejections will go away. But He does say in this portion of scripture that “**In all these things** we are more than conquerors through Him that loved us. “But is this our experience in life? Are we more than conquerors? Or do the trials, rejections, loneliness, fears and worries of life overwhelm us?

As Christians we can know the love and acceptance of our heavenly Father and it is in knowing His love and acceptance that we can face our giants and be more than conquerors. However, we cannot know this love and acceptance of God until we truly know Jesus Christ, for it is in Christ that the Father reveals His love and imparts His acceptance.

Romans 8:38-39 “For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”



The problem is that far too many of those who have yielded their life to Christ and are Christians are not yet persuaded of this truth. The persuading is a growing process; of applying God’s truth found in Scripture to the rejections, trials, temptations and problems of life.

We have an enemy that tries to keep us from this knowledge of God’s love and acceptance. Even As Christians the battles of life go on so how can we overcome? How can we be more than conquerors?

We must learn through the rejections, trials, temptations and problems to **apply** God’s Word to our lives. “More than Conquerors” will help you to face the giants through small group ministry. We will help you to learn to apply the “Seven Biblical Principles to Victory” to your life.

You will learn and grow in victory with others who are dealing and overcoming the same bondage in their lives.

It is our prayer that you will come to know Jesus in a new and fresh way that will bring you to the place of being “More than a Conqueror” over your giants.

Philippians 3:10 That I may know Him, and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being made conformable unto His death.

The Meeting – What to Expect

The goal of More than Conquerors is to lead people to Jesus Christ and then work His biblical principles into our lives. Head knowledge is a great start but if that knowledge is not worked into our day to day lives, then it is of little or no value. At a More than Conquerors meeting you will typically find a small group setting being led by one who has found victory in walking out these principals. The leader will begin by discussing one of the seven principals in depth and then open the meeting up to discussion, questions, and answers. We believe this is the best way for individuals to learn, process, and apply what they are learning. Meetings may vary somewhat in structure based upon the personality of the leader and the leading of the Holy Spirit.
